

20-day 'Modi Fest' to mark 3 yrs of NDA

BJP plans to organise “Modi Fest” in districts across the country from May 26 to June 15 to celebrate “good governance” during three years of the BJP-ruled government at the Centre. During the campaign, themed on “Sabka Saath, Sabka Vikas”, the party’s endeavour will be to reach out to every nook and corner, especially the youth. Ministers and MPs will be assigned districts other than their individual constituencies. “The slogan will reiterate the party’s claim that it is making a difference by pledging welfare of every citizen without any discrimination,” a BJP leader said. The party’s senior leaders have held several rounds of meetings to finalise the blueprint of the celebrations in which information and broadcasting minister Venkaiah Naidu plays a key role.
